VOLUNTARY SURRENDER AGREEMENT

By letter dated September 19, 1985, Beverly Young Bryant was advised by the Maine State Board of Nursing (hereinafter "the Board") that it had received a complaint from Carol Cole, R.N., Health Services Consultant, Division of Licensing and Medical Services of the Department of Human Services, alleging physical and verbal abuse of residents at the Freeport Nursing Home by Mrs. Bryant in her practice of nursing. By letter dated February 7, 1986, Mrs. Bryant was requested to meet with the Board for an informal conference under the provisions of 32 M.R.S.A. Section 2105-A(1).

On March 12, 1986, Mrs. Bryant responded to the Board indicating that she would not attend such an informal conference. Mrs. Bryant subsequently surrendered to the Board her license to practice nursing. The license surrender was by mail without any cover letter from Mrs. Bryant and was received by the Board on March 31, 1986. The Board voted to accept Mrs. Bryant's voluntary surrender of her license to practice as a Licensed Practical Nurse at its meeting on April 8, 1986. It is the understanding of the parties to this agreement that the voluntary surrender of the license and acceptance of this surrender constitute a revocation of the license, and that all parties will treat said license as revoked under Maine Law.

The Board will in the future consider a request from Mrs. Bryant for license reinstatement upon demonstration to the Board that she is competent to safely practice nursing. The Board may, in considering any request from Mrs. Bryant for reinstatement, impose any conditions of probation that it deems necessary to insure that Mrs. Bryant can safely practice nursing as a Liceshed Practical Nurse.
