INTRODUCTION

This document is a Consent Agreement regarding Susan L. Daley's license to practice registered professional nursing in the State of Maine. The parties enter into this Agreement pursuant to 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003(5)(B) and 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A(1-A)(C). The parties to this Consent Agreement are Susan L. Daley ("Licensee"), Maine State Board of Nursing ("Board") and the Department of Attorney General, State of Maine. The parties reached this Agreement following Ms. Daley's request to have her registered professional nurse license permanently revoked by letter dated July 28, 2004. Exhibit 1. In addition, the board has reviewed information submitted by Sisters of Charity Health System in a letter dated May 18, 2004 and information submitted by Department of Human Services – Bureau of Medical Services, Division of Licensing & Certification in Complaint No. 04-ANF-483 dated May 27, 2004. Exhibit 2.

FACTS

- 1. Susan L. Daley has been a registered professional nurse licensed to practice in Maine since 1992.
- 2. Susan L. Daley admits that she diverted 60 milligrams of morphine while employed as a registered professional nurse at St. Mary's Regional Medical Center, Lewiston, Maine.
- 3. Susan L. Daley states that because of both medical and mental health problems that she does not feel that she is safe to practice as a registered professional nurse.
- 4. Susan L. Daley has offered to have her registered professional nurse license permanently revoked.

AGREEMENT

5. On the basis of Fact No. 2, the Maine State Board of Nursing will accept Susan L. Daley's offer to have her registered professional nurse license permanently revoked.

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- 6. Susan L. Daley agrees and understands that this document imposes discipline regarding her license to practice registered professional nursing and based upon Fact No. 2, her conduct constitutes grounds for discipline under 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A(2)(A), (2)(F) and (2)(H) and Chapter, 4(1)(A)(1), 4(1)(A)(6), 4.3.P and 4.3.O of the Rules and Regulation of the Maine State Board of Nursing.
- 7. Susan L. Daley understands and agrees that this Consent Agreement is for the permanent revocation of her registered professional nurse license and that she will never be able to petition the Board for reinstatement of her license in the State of Maine.
- 8. Susan L. Daley shall not work or volunteer, in any capacity, for a health care provider as defined by Title 24 M.R.S.A. § 2502 (2) or in any position holding herself out as a registered professional nurse or with the designation, R.N.
- 9. Susan L. Daley understands that she does not have to execute this Consent Agreement and that she has the right to consult with an attorney before entering into this Consent Agreement.
- 10. Susan L. Daley affirms that she executes this Consent Agreement of her own free will.
- 11. Modification of this Consent Agreement must be in writing and signed by all parties.
- 12. This Consent Agreement is not subject to review or appeal by the Licensee, but may be enforced by an action in the Superior Court.
- 13. This Consent Agreement becomes effective upon the date of the last necessary signature below.

I, SUSAN L. DALEY, HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOREGOING CONSENT AGREEMENT. I UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING IT, I WAIVE CERTAIN RIGHTS. I SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY, WITHOUT ANY THREAT OR PROMISE. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT CONTAINS THE ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND THERE IS NO OTHER AGREEMENT OF ANY KIND.
