Re: ORDER REGARDING REVOCATION OF LICENSE

Dear Ms. Gutierrez:

This will acknowledge the action of the Board on December 14, 1990 regarding your voluntary surrender and revocation of your license.

After meeting with you in informal conference, the Board made the following findings of fact:

- 1. You admit to diversion of drugs and falsifying of records while employed at St. Andrews Hospital.
- 2. You have a previous history of substance abuse and disciplinary action from the State of Arizona.
- 3. You do not have a good support system in place.
- 4. You voluntarily surrendered your registered nurse license.
- 5. You are not presently in counseling.

ORDER

Based on the above findings of fact, the Board makes the following Order:

1. The Board accepts the voluntary surrender of the registered nurse license of Judith A. Gutierrez.

- 2. The Board also finds that Judith A. Gutierrez violated 32 M.R.S.A. Section 2105-A(2)(B).
- 3. The burden of proof of sufficient rehabilitation to warrant the public trust rests solely on Ms. Gutierrez.
- 4. The surrender and revocation of Ms. Gutierrez's registered nurse license is for an indefinite period of time.
