ADMINISTRATIVE CONSENT ACREEMENT

On Friday, January 28, 1983, the Maine State Board of Nursing (hereinafter "the Board") met with Danielle L. Hale, L.P.N., at its offices located at 295 Water Street, Augusta, Maine. Mrs. Hale acknowledged that she had a problem involving the use of drugs.

Based on her presentation before the Board, the Board believes that Mrs. Hale's drug related problem is under control and that her practice of nursing poses no threat to the health and safety of the public. Because of Mrs. Hale's admissions regarding her drug related problem and her willingness to seek therapy to overcome this problem, the Board wishes to resolve this matter without filing an action in Administrative Court. Therefore, Mrs. Hale and the Board hereby agree to the terms of the following consent agreement:

- (1) The Board agrees to allow Mrs. Hale to practice nursing in this state under a probationary status for a period of two (2) years effective January 28, 1983;
- (2) During this two (2) year probationary period, Mrs. Hale agrees to continue her out-patient treatment program for her drug related problem;

- (3) During this two (2) year probationary period,

 Mrs. Hale agrees to submit a written report from

 both her nursing supervisor and her drug counselor

 to the Board every three (3) months concerning her

 progress towards rehabilitation. The first of these

 reports shall be submitted to the Board on or before

 May 1, 1983;
- (4) During this two (2) year probationary period, Mrs. Hale agrees to make each and every nursing supervisor she may have during the course of the two years aware of her drug related problem and of the conditions placed on her license to practice nursing by the terms of this consent agreement;
- (5) Mrs. Hale agrees to meet with the Executive Director and a member of the Board in September, 1983, and in April, 1984, to discuss Mrs. Hale's progress towards rehabilitation. These meetings shall take place at the Board office located at 295 Water Street, Augusta at a time convenient for all parties.

It is understood that if for any reason Mrs. Hale fails to remain drug free or fails to fulfill any of her obligations under this agreement the Board will be released from all its obligations under this agreement and will be free to take whatever action it deems appropriate.
