- 1. The above-captioned proceeding to revoke the nursing license of Linda A. Holbrook was commenced by filing a Complaint with this Court on June 22, 1999.

5. Defendant is not an infant or an incompetent person or a person in military service as defined in Article A-1 of the "Soldiers and Sailors Civil Relief Act" of 1940. See Affidavit of John H. Richards attached hereto as Exhibit A.

WHEREFORE, the plaintiffs respectfully request that the Court hear this matter and take such evidence as may be necessary to enter a decision by default and for the revocation of the nursing license of Linda A. Holbrook or such other relief as this Court deems appropriate.
