This letter is written confirmation of the Board's decision regarding your request for reinstatement of license. As the Board explained to you during its meeting with you on June 11, 1998, the Board remains concerned about possible substance abuse and relapse in light of your admission that you have used alcohol since entering into the 1997 Consent Agreement.

As a result, the Board has denied your request for reinstatement of license at this time. The terms of the Consent Agreement Regarding Reinstatement of License dated January, 1997 shall continue in effect. In June, 1999, you may again petition the Board for reinstatement of your license on probationary status. At that time, the Board will consider again the degree to which you have complied with the terms of the Consent Agreement.
