At its meeting on December 14, 1990, the Board reviewed your November 26, 1990 response to the complaint filed against you on October 30, 1990 by Jackson Brook Institute.

The Board voted to deny approval of your application for license as a registered nurse by endorsement on the basis of violations of the LAW REGULATING THE PRACTICE OF NURSING in Maine, specifically, Section 2105-A(2)(B), (2)(C), (2)(E) and (2)(F). Furthermore, pursuant to the Consent Agreement you entered into with the Board in August of 1990, your application for license by endorsement is denied for violation of paragraph 15 of your consent agreement with the Arizona Board of Nursing.
