CONSENT AGREEMENT REGARDING LICENSURE

### INTRODUCTION

This document is a Consent Agreement regarding Howard John Klopp's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Maine, entered into pursuant to 32 M.R.S.A. Section 2105-A(1-A)(B) and 10 M.R.S.A. Section 8003(5)(B). The parties to this Consent Agreement are: Howard John Klopp, R.N., the Maine State Board of Nursing ("Board") and the Department of Attorney General, State of Maine.

Mr. Klopp has applied for licensure in Maine, and is currently licensed in the State of Georgia pursuant to a Consent Agreement which became effective on August 5, 1994. Under the terms of that Consent Agreement Mr. Klopp's Georgia license is on probation for a four-year period. Mr. Klopp disclosed this fact on his Maine application. The Board subsequently requested that Mr. Klopp meet with the Board to discuss this matter. That meeting was held on April 7, 1994. Mr. Klopp was present without counsel.

COVENANTS

The Board voted to enter into an agreement with Mr. Klopp under which his license is granted with the following conditions:

- 1. Mr. Klopp will remain completely substance-free.
- 2. Mr. Klopp will remain in compliance with his Georgia Consent Agreement.
- 3. Mr. Klopp will notify this Board of his nurse employment status.
- 4. Mr. Klopp will provide copies of this Consent Agreement and of the Georgia Consent Agreement to any nurse employer.
- 5. The Board agrees to take no further action upon these facts so long as Mr. Klopp fully complies with these conditions.
- 6. Mr. Klopp understands that this document is a Consent Agreement which affects his rights to practice nursing in Maine. Mr. Klopp understands that he does not have

to execute this Consent Agreement and that he has the right to consult with an attorney before entering this Consent Agreement. Mr. Klopp affirms that he executes this Consent Agreement of his own free will.
