**INTRODUCTION**

This document rescinds the April 22, 2009 amendment to the November 13, 2007 Consent Agreement regarding Condition #10 affecting Sabrina A. Loring’s advanced nursing practice prescriptive authority in the State of Maine. The parties to this Rescinded Amendment are Sabrina A. Loring (“Licensee” or “Ms. Loring”), Maine State Board of Nursing (“Board”) and the Department of the Attorney General, State of Maine. The Board met with Ms. Loring on September 3, 2009.

**FACTS**

1. Condition #10 of Sabrina A. Loring’s November 13, 2007 Consent Agreement limits her prescriptive authority for scheduled medications to Class IV and V medications. On April 22, 2009, the Board amended the Agreement by expanding Ms. Loring’s prescriptive authority to include Class II and III medications [Exhibit A].
2. On July 24, 2009, Ms. Loring disclosed to the Board that she received an OUI (Operating Under the Influence) on July 8, 2009. She admits that she had a brief relapse by taking Fioricet, a previously prescribed medication for her migraine headaches, prior to the above incident. This is a breach of Condition #7(a) of her November 2007 Consent Agreement.
3. Sabrina A. Loring remains in treatment at Mercy Hospital Recovery Center, is active in her 12-Step work, and attends Caduceus meetings on a regular basis. Her drug screens have been negative since the OUI.

**AMENDMENT RESCINDED**

4. Sabrina A. Loring’s April 2009 Consent Agreement Amendment is hereby rescinded; Condition #10 of the 2007 Agreement is reinstated as originally written as follows:

*Sabrina A. Loring agrees and understands that her prescriptive authority for scheduled medications is limited to Class IV and V medications.*

5. Sabrina A. Loring understands and agrees that the entire Consent Agreement of November 13, 2007 remains in full force and effect.

6. Sabrina A. Loring understands and agrees that the Board will monitor her prescription practice through the State of Maine Prescription Monitoring Program.
7. This Rescinded Amendment of April 22, 2009 becomes effective upon the date of the last necessary signature below.


