INTRODUCTION

The Board of Nursing received a letter dated January 11, 1989 from the Director of Nursing at the Waterville Convalescent Center alleging possible violations of laws governing the practice of practical nursing. Specifically, it was alleged that James Mulrooney, employed as a licensed practical nurse at the facility, walked off the job approximately 30 minutes prior to the end of this shift on January 9, 1989 without reporting or documenting on the care he had given to residents during his shift and that prior to leaving the premises, he was verbally and emotionally abusive to a resident and to other staff members on duty at the time. Mr. Mulrooney was provided notice of these allegations and responded through his attorney by letter dated February 17, 1989. Subsequently, the Board requested that Mr. Mulrooney attend an informal conference pursuant to 32 M.R.S.A. ERROR sub-section 2105-A(1-A). At the informal conference held on (February) 23, 1989, Mr. Mulrooney was present and represented by his attorney Sidney 4 Collar Bar To his attorney, Sidney H. Geller, Esq. The employer, although notified, was not present.

FINDINGS OF FACT

As a result of the informal conference which was held in executive session in accordance with 32 M.R.S.A. sub-section 2105-A(1-A), the Board made the following findings of fact:

- 1. Mr. Mulrooney was verbally abusive to a patient.
- Mr. Mulrooney left the employer's premises prior to the end of his shift without giving a verbal or written report.
- 3. There is no documented evidence of neglect of the patients as a result of Mr. Mulrooney's conduct.

CONCLUSION

Based on the above findings of fact, the Board voted to issue this letter of warning to be placed in Mr. Mulrooney's file.
