CONSENT AGREEMENT REGARDING REINSTATEMENT STATUS OF LICENSE

INTRODUCTION

This document is a Consent Agreement regarding Carol Nigro's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Maine, entered into pursuant to 32 M.R.S.A. Section 2105-A(1-A)(B) and 10 M.R.S.A. Section 8003(5)(B). The parties to this Consent Agreement are: Carol Nigro, R.N., the Maine State Board of Nursing ("Board") and the Department of Attorney General, State of Maine. In 1995 Ms. Nigro entered into a Consent Agreement with the Board and the Department of the Attorney General for drug abuse and diversion of narcotics. Ms. Nigro requested reinstatement of her license, and this Consent Agreement is a result of that request.

COVENANTS

Ms. Nigro's license is reinstated on probation for a period of one year from the date of her next employment in nursing, with the following conditions:

- 2. Ms. Nigro will continue her prescribed aftercare treatment process and self-help recovery program.
- 3. Ms. Nigro will provide to the Board quarterly reports from her substance abuse counselor so long as she remains in treatment. Ms. Nigro waives any claims of confidentiality and privilege which she may have with respect to these reports.
- 4. Ms. Nigro will provide a copy of this Consent Agreement to any nurse employer.
- 5. Ms. Nigro will provide to the Board quarterly reports from any nurse employer. Ms. Nigro waives any claims of confidentiality and privilege which she may have with respect to these reports.
- 6. Ms. Nigro will notify the Board when she resumes employment in nursing, and will notify the Board of any change in her nursing employment.

7. Ms. Nigro understands that this document is a Consent Agreement which affects her legal right to practice nursing in Maine. Ms. Nigro understands that she does not have to execute this Consent Agreement and that she has the right to consult with an attorney before entering this Consent Agreement. Ms. Nigro affirms that she executes this Consent Agreement of her own free will.
