ADMINISTRATIVE CONSENT AGREEMENT

On July 24, 1979, Ibra L. Ripley's license to practice nursing in Maine was voluntarily surrendered to the Maine State Board of Nursing, pursuant to an agreement between Mr. Ripley and James G. Boulos, Assistant Attorney General, which was documented on Ninth District Court Complaint entitled State v. Ibra Ripley, 78/9 Docket No. 28295. On January 30, 1981 the Board met with Mr. Ripley and his attorney, Mr. O'Brien, to discuss reinstatement of Mr. Ripley's license to practice nursing, pursuant to the aforementioned agreement. At that meeting, Mr. Ripley presented evidence to the satisfaction of the Board that, upon reinstatement of his license on May 1, 1981, he may safely practice nursing subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Ripley will be on probation for two years, and thereafter for as long as the Board finds to be necessary, but not to exceed five years. The probationary period will commence on the date Mr. Ripley begins employment in nursing, and will abate for the duration of any period in which Mr. Ripley ceases to be employed in nursing.
- (2) During the first two years of probation, Mr. Ripley will not acquire training or employment as a Registered Nurse Anesthetist.
- (3) During the first two years of probation, Mr. Ripley shall be employed only in an acute care facility, unless the Board grants

prior approval of an alternative employment position. Mr. Ripley shall inform the Board of any such facility in which he accepts employment.

- (4) During the entire period of probation, Mr. Ripley will inform each of his employers of the terms and conditions of this agreement.
- (5) During the entire period of probation, Mr. Ripley will meet and confer with the Board once every three months for the first year and, during the subsequent years, periodically as the Board shall then require. Prior to any such conference, Mr. Ripley shall submit to the Board written documentation from his nurse supervisor as to his work performance.
- (6) At the end of the first year of probation, Mr. Ripley will undergo a psychiatric evaluation of his rehabilitation progress and submit to the Board a written statement thereof by the psychiatrist.

Failure by Mr. Ripley to adhere to any of these conditions will result in an automatic revocation of this reinstatement agreement, and the Board shall be free to take whatever action it deems necessary. The terms of this agreement do not affect the application to Mr. Ripley or to the Board of any other statute of the State of Maine, or any rule or regulation of the Maine State Board of Nursing.

The terms of this agreement are seen and agreed to.
