FOR LICENSE PROBATION

INTRODUCTION

This document amends the July 9, 2008 Consent Agreement (“Agreement”) pursuant to Condition #5 regarding Renee L. Walker’s license to practice registered professional nursing in the State of Maine. The parties to this Amendment are Renee L. Walker (“Licensee” or “Ms. Walker”), Maine State Board of Nursing (“Board”) and the Office of the Attorney General, State of Maine. The Board met with Ms. Walker on September 2, 2009 regarding her request to amend her 2008 Agreement regarding on-site supervision by another registered professional nurse.

FACTS

1. Renee L. Walker entered into a Consent Agreement with the Board in July 2008 for license reinstatement and probation for a term of five years. Condition #5 of the Agreement restricts her employment during the period of probation to “. . . *structured settings with on-site supervision by another registered professional nurse.*”
2. Renee L. Walker is in compliance with the existing terms and conditions of her Agreement. She provided the Board with correspondence from Cedar Ridge Center dated July 31, 2009, signed by Michael McDougall, Administrator; Susan Hoyt-Russell, RN, Director of Nursing; and Kim Connelly, RN, Skilled Unit Manager supporting Ms. Walker’s request to amend the Agreement [Exhibit 1].

AMENDMENT

3. Renee L. Walker’s July 2008 Consent Agreement with the Board is hereby **AMENDED** as follows:

“5. Renee L. Walker’s employment is restricted during the period of probation to structured settings. Structured settings shall not include assignments from temporary employment agencies, home health, school nursing, work as a travel nurse or within the correctional system.”

4. Renee L. Walker understands and agrees that this Amendment supplants Condition #5 of the July 9, 2008 Agreement and that the entire remaining Agreement continues in full force and effect.
5. This Amendment becomes effective upon the date of the last necessary signature below.


