INTRODUCTION

This document is a Consent Agreement regarding Christine E. Webster's license to practice practical nursing in the State of Maine. The parties enter into this Agreement pursuant to 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A(1-A)(A), 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003(5)(A-1)(1) and § 8003(5)(B). The parties to this Consent Agreement are Christine E. Webster ("Licensee"), Maine State Board of Nursing ("Board") and the Office of the Attorney General, State of Maine. An informal conference was held on August 22, 2006. The parties reached this agreement based upon information submitted by Greenwood Center pursuant to 24 M.R.S.A. § 2506, through a letter dated July 22, 2005 and a Complaint from the Division of Licensing & Certification, Maine Department of Health and Human Services dated September 12, 2005.

FACTS

1. Christine E. Webster has been a licensed practical nurse licensed to practice in Maine since 1991.
2. Christine E. Webster documented and reported to the Director of Nursing an incident of resident abuse but failed to complete her responsibility to ensure that the incident was reported to the Maine Department of Health and Human Services. By failing to complete the reporting process Ms. Webster failed to adequately advocate for the resident.

AGREEMENT

3. Christine E. Webster understands that her conduct in the above stated facts constitutes grounds for discipline under Title 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A(2)(F), (2)(H) and Chapter 4.1.A.6., and Chapter 4.3.F. of the Rules and Regulations of the Maine State Board of Nursing. Christine E. Webster is hereby **CENSURED** for unprofessional conduct because she failed to follow policies and procedures in a practice situation designed to safeguard the patient.
4. Christine E. Webster understands that this Consent Agreement imposes discipline in the form of a censure regarding her license to practice practical nursing in the State of Maine. Ms. Webster understands that she does not have to execute this Consent Agreement and that she has the right to consult with an attorney before entering into this Consent Agreement.
