

NCLEX "FIRST TIME" TEST TAKERS PASS RATES

Practical Nurses For the year October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014, 169 first time candidates educated in Maine wrote the NCLEX examination for practical nurses and 74 passed, a 44% pass rate.

The national pass rate for the same time period was 82.81%.

(The total number of U.S. educated P.N. candidates was 56,542 with 46,824 passing the first time)

Registered Nurses For the year October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014, 739 first time candidates educated in Maine wrote the NCLEX examination for registered nurses and 641 passed, an 86.74 % pass rate. The national pass rate for the same time period was 81.74%.

(The total number and percent passing of first time candidates educated in U.S. jurisdictions: 155,585 R.N. candidates; 127,181 passed first time for the 81.74% pass rate)
