

NCLEX-RN “FIRST TIME” TEST TAKERS PASS RATE

Practical Nurses: For the time period January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016, 61 first time candidates educated in Maine wrote the NCLEX examination for practical nurses and 42 passed; a 68.85% pass rate.

The national pass rate for the same time period was 83.73%.

(The total number of U.S. educated PN candidates was 47,284 with 83.73% passing the first time).

Registered Nurses: For the time period January 1, 2016 through September 30, 2016, 783 first time candidates educated in Maine wrote the NCLEX examination for registered nurses and 659 passed; a 84.16% pass rate.

The national pass rate for the same time period was 84.57%.

(The total number of U.S. educated RN candidates was 157,073 with 84.57% passing the first time).
