Per RFA Attachment B- Scoring Rubric: A collaborative approach is preferred. Applicants may be planning on working with agricultural service providers or farmers, and they should be listed accordingly, with the most points going to projects in which the agricultural service provider has already been identified. Each collaborator should have clearly defined roles and responsibilities. Collaboration can be as simple as using soil from an impacted farm. Additional points are not awarded based on a threshold of involvement.

If desired, applicants may include a letter of support to indicate that a farmer or agricultural producer is committed to the project if grant funding is received.
