Maine Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) Income Guidelines

New to 2025, CSFP applicants will be income eligible automatically if they participate in any of the five below federal programs:

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Medicare Savings Programs (MSP) The Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR) The Low-Income Subsidy Program (LIS) Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

Verbal attestation of participation in any of the 5 programs above is considered sufficient proof of income.

Alternatively, applicants not participating in any of the above programs may use the following thresholds to determine their income eligibility for CSFP in Maine.
