To clarify your comments, the lagoon would not need permits from DEP. However, any expansion of the lagoon would require a Shoreland Alteration permit from LUPC, since it is a constructed pond greater than 4,300 square feet in size. Are you removing the expansion of the lagoon from the current proposal? If not, will you be submitting the additional Shoreland Alteration Permit

application/information that I emailed Matt Dieterich about in order to permit the expansion?

I spoke with Clarissa Trasko (DEP Wastewater Department) this morning about the old treatment lagoon. She said the lagoon has not been used for approx. 15 years so anything that was in the pond is essentially gone now. We do not need to do anything with the pond during this phase or if we expand the pond in the future. We don't need to clean the pond out and no permits through the wastewater division. If the pond will be used as a treatment lagoon in the future the new will need to contact Clarissa for permitting.
