All applicants for commercial bear bait sites must possess and provide on request a current certificate of insurance evidencing that they have secured at their expense liability insurance issued by a company fully licensed or designated as an eligible surplus lines insurer to do business in this State by the Maine Department of Professional & Financial Regulation, Bureau of Insurance, which policy includes the activity to be covered by the bear bait site permit with limits of not less than \$500,000 per occurrence single limit and an annual aggregate limit of not less than \$1,000,000.
