Do you have an old shed with unusable pesticides? An old can of raid under the sink? An unknown barrel of something inherited from the previous owner? Sign up for the Obsolete Pesticide Collection Program today to safely and responsibly remove hazardous waste from your property. Available to Maine residents, gardeners, and small family-owned farms.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

All participants must fill out a registration form with a list of all pesticides/adjuvants that they would like to submit. Forms can be submitted on our on-line application or emailed to pesticides@maine.gov. To fill out our on-line application, visit thinkfirstspraylast.org or scan the QR code. All participants will be notified in early October via mail of the program date, time, and location. Any unknown pesticides must be verified prior to acceptance.
