**Subject: Ellsworth Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2727)
Application for Water Quality Certification**

Dear Ms. Paye:

Black Bear Hydro Partners, LLC (Black Bear), a subsidiary of Brookfield Renewable, is herein submitting to the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (MDEP) an application for Water Quality Certification (WQC) for the Ellsworth Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2727) (Project). The Project, which consists of two developments – the Ellsworth Development and the Graham Lake Development – is located on the Union River in the City of Ellsworth, the Towns of Waltham and Mariaville, and the Township of Fletchers Landing in Hancock County, Maine.

Black Bear filed the Final License Application (FLA) for the relicensing of the Project with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or Commission) on December 30, 2015. The Commission issued notice that the Project was ready for environmental analysis on February 9, 2018, and issued a Final Environmental Assessment on July 29, 2019.

On March 21, 2019, Black Bear applied to the MDEP for WQC for the Project under Section 401 of the Federal Clean Water Act. On March 19, 2020, the MDEP issued a Denial of the WQC. An appeal process followed, which concluded in a January 21, 2025 decision by the Maine Supreme Judicial Court, that “Black Bear’s appeals to both the Superior Court and the Law Court must be dismissed as nonjusticiable, as no decision by either court would provide relief from the Board’s denial of the application for a Water Quality Certification.”¹ By letter filed on February 18, 2025, and in accordance with the Commission’s policy in *Swift River Company*², Black Bear requested an extension of 60 days beyond the 90-day period (i.e., until June 20, 2025), to refile a new application for certification with MDEP to allow more time for consultation with MDEP and potential additional parties during the development of the certification application. On March 12, 2025, the Commission issued a letter granting an extension and specifying that Black Bear should

notify the Commission that it has refiled its certification request with the MDEP by June 20, 2025. Accordingly, Black Bear is filing a new application for WQC.

This WQC application includes two notable changes from Black Bear's previous proposals to support obtaining a WQC for the Project: modifying the operating regime in Graham Lake and a water quality enhancement program for Lake Leonard. These changes are proposed to improve water quality at the Project, were developed in consultation with the MDEP, and are described in greater detail in Attachment 1 of this application.

Pursuant to 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §121.4, Black Bear requested a pre-filing meeting with the MDEP on May 7, 2025, and the meeting was held on May 9, 2025, via teleconference. As discussed during the pre-filing meeting, Black Bear is submitting this application electronically and is hand delivering a hard copy of the application form with a check for the processing fee to the MDEP. Black Bear is also providing a copy of the WQC application to the City of Ellsworth, the Towns of Waltham and Mariaville, and Hancock County Commissioners.

Black Bear hereby requests that the MDEP review and take action on this WQC request within the applicable period of time and provide a draft of the WQC for review before issuing the final WQC. If the MDEP requires access and entry to the property and facilities under this certification, Black Bear respectfully requests that the MDEP coordinate accompanied access with Black Bear prior to any inspections deemed necessary by MDEP to help ensure access as needed and the safety of on-site operating staff and MDEP staff.



WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION APPLICATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. By submitting this application, an applicant requests Water Quality Certification pursuant to Section 401 of the Federal Clean Water Act for the continued operation of an existing hydropower generating or storage project under the terms of an initial or a new license from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission. Certification must be obtained for any activity requiring a federal license or permit which may result in a discharge into the navigable waters of the United States.
2. The purpose of this application form is to obtain from the applicant a thorough description of project facilities and operation and the impacts of the continued operation of the project on water quality.

The Department's Regulations provide that the applicant bears the burden of proof in the application process. This is the burden of presenting sufficient evidence for the Department to make the affirmative findings required by law regarding matters about which no questions are raised and the burden of presenting a preponderance of the evidence regarding matters about which questions are raised.

3. In order to grant certification, the Department must conclude that there is a reasonable assurance that the continued operation of a hydropower generating or storage project will not violate applicable Water Quality Standards. These standards have been established in the State's Water Classification Program (Title 38 MRSA Sections 464-469). These standards designate the uses and related characteristics of those uses for each class of water and establish water quality criteria necessary to protect those uses and related characteristics.
4. Any applicant for a FERC license must complete a three stage consultation process with appropriate state and federal agencies. The purpose of this process is to identify and analyze the potential environmental and socioeconomic impacts of a project.

The consultation process requires an applicant to have either requested or obtained water quality certification at the time of filing with FERC. The process also requires that an applicant serve a copy of its FERC application, including any revisions, supplements or amendments thereto, on each of the agencies consulted.

Ellsworth Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2727)
Additional Information for Water Quality Certification Application

Black Bear Hydro Partners, LLC (Black Bear or Licensee) is the Licensee of the Ellsworth Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2727) (Project). The Project is located on the Union River in Hancock County, Maine. The Project consists of two developments, the Ellsworth Development and the Graham Lake Development, with a total installed capacity of 8.9 megawatts (MW).

The Ellsworth Development consists of the Ellsworth Dam, which forms the 90-acre Lake Leonard, and the associated generating facilities. The Ellsworth Dam forms the upper limit of tidal influence of the Union River. The Graham Lake Development consists of a dam with a large storage reservoir (Graham Lake). There are no generating facilities at the Graham Lake Development.

The Project is operated pursuant to the license issued by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or Commission) on December 28, 1987. The Project is typically run as a peaking facility, with water released from the Graham Lake reservoir used to generate electricity at the downstream Ellsworth powerhouse. As part of the current license requirements, the Licensee is required to release a continuous minimum flow of 105 cubic feet per second (cfs) from the Graham Lake Development and the Ellsworth Development from July 1 through April 30 and 250 cfs from May 1 through June 30. In addition, the existing license requires Black Bear to maintain lake elevations between 93.4 and 104.2 feet at Graham Lake and between 65.7 and 66.7 feet at Lake Leonard.

Background

The Project's existing license expired on December 31, 2017¹; therefore, Black Bear filed an Application for New License (Final License Application [FLA]) for the Project with FERC on December 30, 2015. In the FLA, Black Bear proposed to continue the current licensed operations for minimum flows and impoundment elevations at the Project, among other proposed measures. On February 9, 2018, the Commission issued notice that the Project was ready for environmental analysis, which required Black Bear to file for Water Quality Certification (WQC) under section 401 of the Clean Water Act no later than 60 days following the issuance of the notice.

On April 9, 2018, the Licensee filed an initial Application for WQC with the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (MDEP). On March 21, 2019, Black Bear withdrew its April 9, 2018 application and filed a new application with the MDEP that materially revised its operating proposals in response to FERC's analysis in the Draft Environmental Assessment (DEA) that was

issued by FERC on November 21, 2018. Black Bear's revised operating proposal included a reduction in the annual operating range of Graham Lake from 10.8 feet (104.2 to 93.4 feet) to 5.7 feet (104.2 to 98.5 feet). Additionally, Black Bear proposed an increase in seasonal minimum flows from 105 cfs to 125 cfs from April 1 to April 30 and July 1 to December 31, or ice-in. The proposed increase in minimum flow was anticipated to enhance downstream fish passage, and, in combination with the proposed narrowing of the Graham Lake operating range, these measures were expected to enhance downstream aquatic habitat and allow the Project to meet water quality standards.

Since Black Bear submitted the WQC application, the FERC relicensing process has continued and the Commission and other agencies have taken important actions for the relicensing of the Project, including:

- On March 27, 2018, the Maine Department of Marine Resources (MDMR) filed recommendations under Section 10(j) of the Federal Power Act (FPA) for the protection, mitigation, or enhancement of fish and wildlife resources affected by the Project with FERC. In addition, on April 10, 2018, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) also filed recommendations under Section 10(j).
- On April 10, 2018, the USFWS and the National Maine Fisheries Service (NMFS) each filed preliminary fishway prescriptions for the Project and requested that the Commission include a reservation of authority to prescribe fishways under Section 18 of the FPA in any license issued for the Project. NMFS then filed modified fishway prescriptions on April 24, 2019. On April 22, 2019, USFWS filed a letter stating that its preliminary prescriptions should be incorporated, unchanged and unmodified, as the final prescriptions in any new license.
- On September 28, 2018, Black Bear filed an updated draft Biological Assessment (BA), as well as a Species Protection Plan (SPP) for Atlantic salmon, shortnose sturgeon, and Atlantic sturgeon, with FERC which was developed in consultation with NMFS and USFWS.
- On July 29, 2019, FERC issued a Final Environmental Assessment (FEA). In the FEA, FERC adopted the Section 18 fishway prescriptions, Section 10(j) recommendations (as appropriate), and included a draft license article for Black Bear to update the SPP after license issuance in consultation with NMFS, USFWS, and MDMR. FERC recommended that Graham Lake be operated between the elevations of 98.5 and 103.0 feet to reduce Project effects on turbidity, sedimentation, and littoral habitat. Additionally, FERC recommended a minimum flow of 105 cfs from January 1 to March 31; 123 cfs from April 1 to April 30; 250 cfs from May 1 to June 30; and 123 cfs from July 1 to December 31, or ice-in.
- On February 27, 2020, NMFS issued a Biological Opinion (BO) under Section 7(a)(2) of the Endangered Species Act (ESA) regarding the effects of the proposed relicensing of the Project on federally listed Atlantic salmon, shortnose sturgeon, and any Distinct Population

Segment (DPS) of Atlantic sturgeon. An incidental take statement was provided with the BO under Section 7(b)(4) of the ESA.

- On July 17, 2020, the MDMR concurred with Black Bear’s Coastal Zone Management Act (CZMA) consistency statement included in a May 29, 2018 letter that the relicensing of the Project complies with the enforceable policies of the Maine Coastal Zone Management Program on the condition that Black Bear receives WQC for the Project, along with any and all MDEP conditions. On August 17, 2020, Black Bear submitted a letter to MDMR and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) to confirm that the July 17, 2020 letter from MDMR with its CZMA consistency response was a concurrence, as opposed to a “conditional concurrence,” with Black Bear’s consistency certification. On August 18, 2020, the MDMR responded noting that “its consistency response in this instance should be considered a concurrence.” On August 26, 2020, NOAA responded that it understood the MDMR’s July 17, 2020 response “was a concurrence without conditions and, therefore, the necessary CZMA compliance for the Project is complete.” Black Bear filed this correspondence with FERC on August 28, 2020.

On March 19, 2020, MDEP issued a denial of the certification, concluding that the Project, as proposed, would not meet water quality standards². Accordingly, in consultation with the MDEP, Black Bear is filing a new application for WQC to reflect two new proposed measures for the operation of the Project including modifying the operating regime for Graham Lake and a water quality enhancement program for Lake Leonard.

Additional Information for Water Quality Certification Application Form

1. NATURE OF ACTIVITY

Subsequent to filing the FLA with FERC on December 30, 2015, Black Bear also filed the following supplemental information for the license application with FERC³:

- May 12, 2016 – Black Bear filed a response to FERC’s January 29, 2016, Additional Information Request (AIR).
- December 22, 2016 – Black Bear filed the 2016 “Evaluation of Atlantic Salmon Smolt Passage” and “Tributary Access Study” reports.
- December 19, 2017 – Black Bear filed the 2017 “Evaluation of Atlantic Salmon Smolt Passage” and “Evaluation of Survival and Injury Occurrence Associated with Downstream Passage for Juvenile Salmonids” reports.
- October 10, 2018 – Black Bear filed a response to FERC’s September 13, 2018, AIR.

- January 7, 2020⁴ and February 7, 2020 – Black Bear filed a response to FERC’s August 7, 2019, AIR.

Within this application, Black Bear is providing the MDEP with the FLA as well as the aforementioned documents filed with FERC that revise, supplement, and/or correct deficiencies in the license application by reference and direct link to the documents in FERC’s eLibrary (Appendix A). Additionally, since the WQC application relies on the FERC license application, Black Bear has updated specific sections of the FLA for the MDEP to reflect the new proposed measures, which are being submitted within this application as specified below.

During periods when inflow to Graham Lake is less than the required minimum flow, the Licensee shall continue to release the minimum flow at each development by drawing from the Graham Lake impoundment, which may result in the Graham Lake elevation being drawn down below 100.1 feet msl.

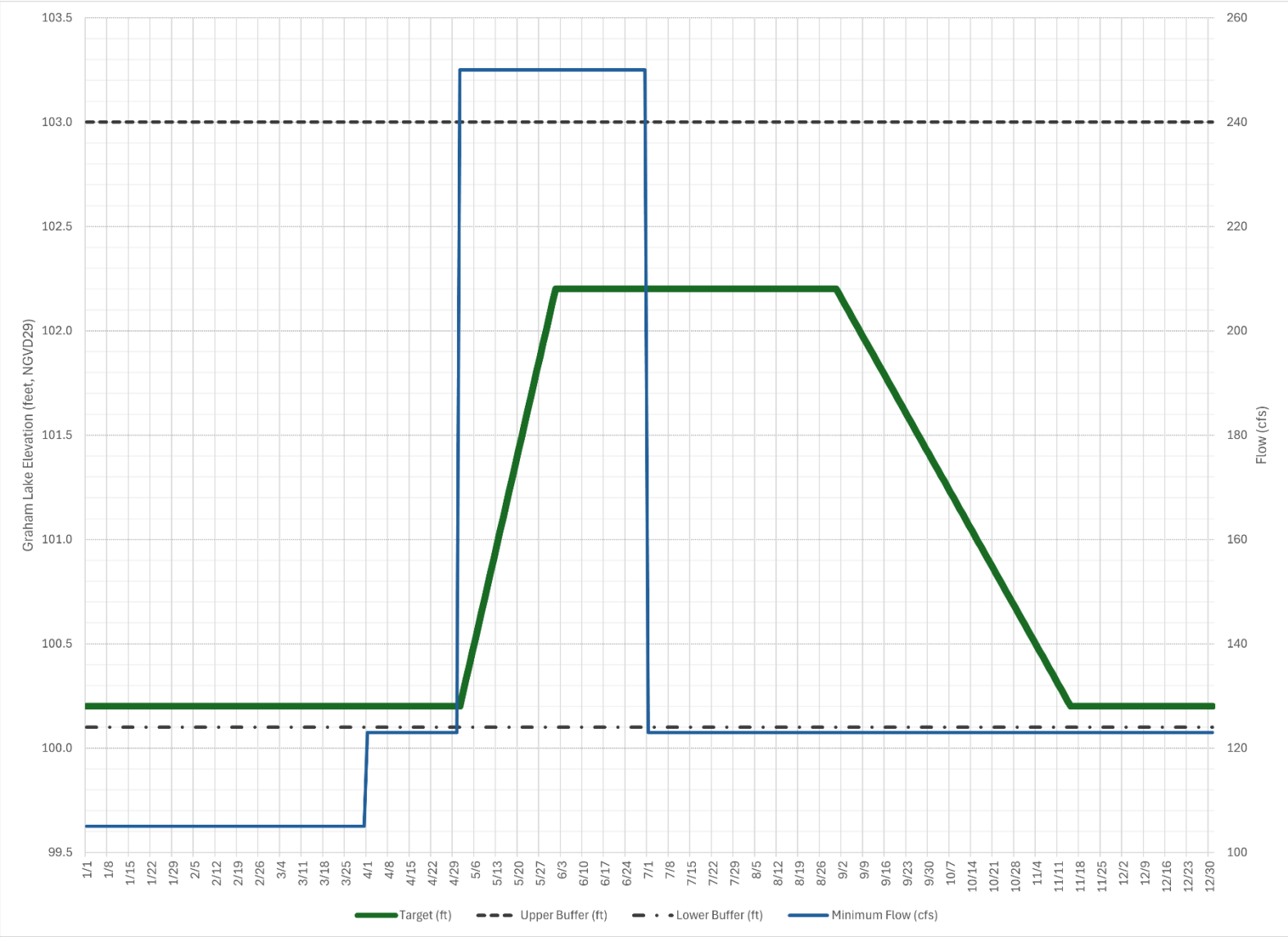

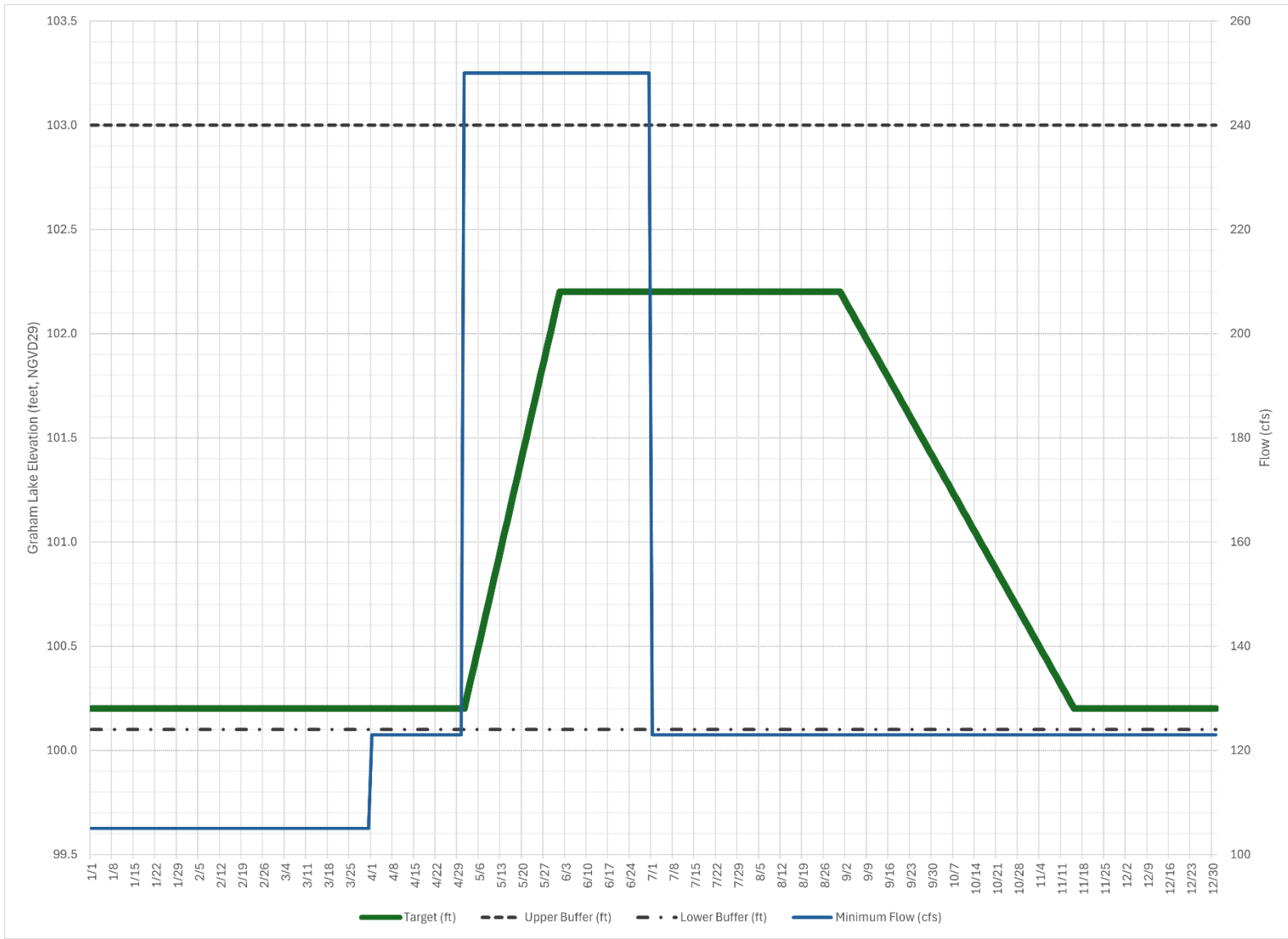

3.3.4 Proposed Environmental Measures

The Protection, Mitigation, and Enhancement (PM&E) measures that Black Bear proposed in the Final License Application (FLA) for the management of resources are below and remain unchanged. However, since the issuance of the FLA, important actions for the relicensing of the Project have been taken related to these items including:

- On March 27, 2018, the MDMR filed recommendations under Section 10(j) of the Federal Power Act (FPA) for the protection, mitigation, or enhancement of fish and wildlife resources affected by the Project with FERC. In addition, on April 10, 2018, the USFWS also filed recommendations under Section 10(j).
- On April 10, 2018, the USFWS and NMFS each filed preliminary fishway prescriptions for the Project and requested that the Commission include a reservation of authority to prescribe fishways under Section 18 of the FPA in any license issued for the Project. NMFS filed modified fishway prescriptions on April 24, 2019. On April 22, 2019, USFWS filed a letter stating that its preliminary prescriptions should be incorporated, unchanged and unmodified, as the final prescriptions in any new license.
- On September 28, 2018, Black Bear filed an updated draft Biological Assessment (BA) with FERC together with a Species Protection Plan (SPP) for Atlantic salmon, shortnose sturgeon, and Atlantic sturgeon, each of which was developed in consultation with NMFS and USFWS.
- On July 29, 2019, FERC issued its FEA for the Project. In the FEA, FERC adopted the Section 18 fishway prescriptions, Section 10(j) recommendations (as appropriate), and included a draft license article for Black Bear to update the SPP after license issuance in consultation with NMFS, USFWS, and MDMR. FERC recommended that Graham Lake be operated between the elevations of 98.5 and 103.0 feet to reduce Project effects on turbidity, sedimentation, and littoral habitat. Additionally, FERC recommended a minimum flow of 105 cfs from January 1 to March 31; 123 cfs from April 1 to April 30; 250 cfs from May 1 to June 30; and 123 cfs from July 1 to December 31, or ice-in.
- On February 27, 2020, NMFS issued a Biological Opinion (BO) under Section 7(a)(2) of the Endangered Species Act (ESA) regarding the effects of the proposed relicensing of the Project on federally listed Atlantic salmon, shortnose sturgeon, and any Distinct Population Segment (DPS) of Atlantic sturgeon. An incidental take statement was provided with the BO under Section 7(b)(4) of the ESA.

Proposed Environmental Measures (as provided in FLA)

- Implement the following recreation proposals:
 - Implement erosion control measures at the existing Graham Lake boat launch facility;
 - Develop a new portage trail at the west end of Graham Lake Dam;
 - Improve a fisherman’s downstream access trail on the east side of Graham Lake Dam;
 - Implement a Recreation Facilities Management Plan to include the above measures and management of recreational facilities at the Project;
- Develop, in consultation with fisheries management agencies, plans for upstream eel passage at Ellsworth and Graham Lake Dams;
- Consult with the fisheries management agencies on the need for and, if necessary, the design of downstream eel passage measures pending the results of downstream eel passage studies;
- Consult with the agencies on the need for and, if necessary, the design of upstream and downstream anadromous fish passage improvements pending the results of ongoing studies;
- Finalize and implement a Historic Properties Management Plan to provide for management of historic resources throughout the term of the new FERC license;
- Finalize and implement an Operations Monitoring Plan specifying the methods the Licensee will use to monitor and report the provision of minimum flows and pond levels, to confirm that the Project is operated in compliance with the new FERC license.

New Proposed Environmental Measures

- As described in Section 3.3.3, Black Bear proposes to further reduce the operational range of Graham Lake to meet aquatic life and habitat standards and enhance water quality in Graham Lake and the Union River.
- If MDEP continues to consider Lake Leonard as Class B waters and not Class GPA, Black Bear is proposing to implement a water quality enhancement program for Lake Leonard, which will be developed in consultation with the MDEP and include the installation, operation, and maintenance of an oxygen injection, or comparable, system to enhance dissolved oxygen (DO) concentrations within the impoundment.

4.4.2 Water Resources

4.4.2.2 Environmental Analysis

Effects of continued project operation on water quality

Impoundment Water Quality

As described above, impoundment water quality sampling was conducted in accordance with MDEP’s Lake Trophic State Sampling Protocol for Hydropower Studies on a bi-weekly basis in Graham Lake from April 23 through October 24, 2013, and in Lake Leonard from June 13 through October 24, 2013. Results of the sampling indicate that Graham Lake meets the applicable Class GPA trophic state standards and is free of culturally induced algal blooms which might impair its use or enjoyment.

The 90-acre Lake Leonard impoundment would also meet the standards for GPA waters, which are defined in 38 M.R.S.A. §480-B(5) as “...any inland bodies of water artificially formed or increased which have a surface area in excess of 30 acres.” Although Black Bear continues to believe that Lake Leonard should be classified as GPA waters due to the size of the impoundment and other characteristics of the lake (e.g., depths, thermal stratification), the MDEP currently considers Lake Leonard as Class B waters. Based on depth profile data collected in Lake Leonard during the water quality study conducted every two weeks from mid-June through late-October 2013 at a deep-water site approximately 300 feet upstream of the Ellsworth Dam, the MDEP determined in the *Denial of Water Quality Certification* issued for the Project on March 19, 2020, that DO concentrations in Lake Leonard do not meet or exceed Class B numeric water quality standards for DO.

If MDEP continues to consider Lake Leonard Class B waters, Black Bear is proposing to implement a water quality enhancement program for Lake Leonard, which will be developed in consultation with the MDEP and include the installation, operation, and maintenance of an oxygen injection, or comparable, system to enhance DO concentrations within Lake Leonard.

Riverine Water Quality

Weekly tailwater water quality sampling downstream of Graham Lake Dam was conducted in accordance with MDEP’s River Sampling Protocol from July 2 through September 12, 2013, in both the early morning (before 7:00 AM) and afternoon (after 1:00 PM) on each sampling day. Tailrace sampling was not conducted in the Ellsworth Dam tailrace, as the Union River is subject to tidal fluctuations at that point. Results of the sampling indicate that Class B physical and chemical water quality standards were met in the tailwater downstream of Graham Lake Dam.

Effects of continued project operation on aquatic habitat

Impoundment Aquatic Habitat

MDEP considers aquatic life and habitat standards in determining whether a water body is meeting water quality standards. It is MDEP's position that there must be both sufficient quality and quantity of habitat for aquatic organisms to meet aquatic life and habitat standards. The MDEP has a hydropower policy which states that, generally, water levels providing wetted conditions for $\frac{3}{4}$ (75%) of the littoral zone of a lake or pond, as measured from full pond conditions, are sufficient to meet aquatic life and habitat standards. MDEP defines the depth of the littoral zone as twice the average Secchi depth. Therefore, 75 percent of the area between the maximum water surface elevation and the elevation at twice the Secchi depth should remain wetted to comply with MDEP's policy. The average Secchi depth for Graham Lake during the 2013 water quality study was 1.77 meters (5.8 feet), which indicates that the depth of the littoral zone is 3.54 meters, or 11.6 feet (twice the average Secchi depth).

Black Bear determined the water level in Graham Lake where 75 percent of the littoral zone is wetted (from the FERC-recommended maximum full pond elevation in the FEA of 103.0 feet) using elevation-surface area relationships. Available spot depth readings from Graham Lake depth sounding maps developed by the MDIFW (1980) were digitized. Contours were estimated based on lake elevations, and GIS tools were used to calculate the surface area of the elevation contours. Wetted littoral zone areas were calculated at specified elevations using ArcGIS Pro v3.3.2 software. The area of Graham Lake at a full pond elevation of 103.0 feet was calculated as 9,772 acres. From an elevation of 103.0 feet, the littoral zone extends to an elevation of 91.4 feet; Black Bear estimated that the area of Graham Lake at this elevation is approximately 5,345 acres. Therefore, the area of the littoral zone is approximately 4,428 acres, and an elevation of 100.1 feet and an area of 8,665 acres would result in 75 percent of the littoral zone being wetted. Black Bear requested confirmation from the MDEP regarding this calculation. In an email dated March 18, 2025, the MDEP confirmed that at least 75 percent of the littoral zone area will remain wetted at a full drawdown elevation of 100.1 feet from a full pond elevation of 103.0 feet. Therefore, as described in Section 3.3.3 of this license application, Black Bear proposes to target water levels at or above 100.1 feet msl in Graham Lake to maintain 75 percent of the wetted littoral area^c.

As stated in FERC's FEA, "Allowing a greater percentage of the littoral zone to remain permanently wetted would provide three important benefits for fish and other aquatic organisms. First, it would increase the amount of juvenile, adult, and foraging habitat available to fish on a more consistent basis. Second, additional persistent aquatic habitat availability could enhance

^c During periods when inflow to Graham Lake is less than the required minimum flow, the Licensee shall continue to release the minimum flow by drawing from the impoundment, which may result in Graham Lake elevation being drawn down below 100.1 feet msl.

populations of macroinvertebrates, a valuable food source for fish. Third, a larger and more stable littoral zone would allow existing beds of aquatic vegetation, which are currently rare in Graham Lake (Black Bear Hydro, 2014), to expand over time and also allow new areas to be colonized by aquatic vegetation. Submerged aquatic vegetation provides habitat for aquatic macroinvertebrates and fish (Miller et al., 2018), stabilizes sediments, reduces resuspension of sediment, and reduces turbidity (Madsen et al., 2001), which could further increase the depth of Graham Lake’s littoral zone.”

Lake Leonard is operated as run-of-river. As such, Lake Leonard essentially maintains a fully wetted littoral zone.

Riverine Aquatic Habitat

Macroinvertebrate sampling in 2014 showed a hyperdominance of net spinning caddisflies in the Graham Lake tailwater, a phenomenon commonly seen in rivers below lakes and reservoirs. Following consultation with MDEP, additional macroinvertebrate sampling was conducted in the summer of 2015. The results of the additional sampling are similar to the sampling results from the 2014 sampling; i.e., there was a hyperdominance of certain species that is common below both reservoirs and natural lakes. The 2015 Macroinvertebrate Sampling Study is presented in Appendix E-3. Based on the MDEP linear discriminant model used to assess attainment with state water quality standards, the Union River downstream of Graham Lake Dam achieves a Class C aquatic life standard^d. In the Denial of Water Quality Certification, the MDEP concluded that “the habitat downstream of the Graham Lake Dam has a diminished capacity to support the aquatic life expected to exist there as a result of turbidity caused from the Graham Lake drawdown and discharged at the dam and therefore, the Department finds the that the aquatic habitat in the Union River between the Graham Lake Dam and Leonard Lake is impaired”. Regardless of how the Project is operated, it is likely that the riverine reach below Graham Lake will continue to support a macroinvertebrate community dominated by species that are responsive to the abundant food source provided downstream of a large lake. However, as discussed in Section 3.3.3, Black Bear is proposing to target water levels at or above 100.1 feet msl in Graham Lake. As discussed above, this is anticipated to enhance vegetative growth and help stabilize shorelines, which could reduce erosion and turbidity and benefit aquatic habitat and organisms. As stated in FERC’s FEA, “Settling sediment reduces the quality of cobble and gravel substrate in lotic and lentic habitats by filling in the interstitial spaces, which reduces the quality of macroinvertebrate habitat (Gammon, 1970; Donohue and Garcia Molinos, 2009). In turn, the reduction in habitat quality can reduce the abundance of macroinvertebrates and alter the species composition of the macroinvertebrate community (Gammon, 1970; Donohue and

^d As summarized in the MDEP’s Denial of Water Quality Certification, additional macroinvertebrate data were submitted to the Department by the Applicant for 2015 and 2019 for analysis using a linear discriminant model, which also found that the Union River immediately downstream of the Graham Lake Dam does not meet the applicable Class B aquatic life standards.

Garcia Molinos, 2009)”. The operating regime that Black Bear is proposing in Graham Lake is anticipated to reduce turbidity in the lake and thereby reduce turbidity in the Union River, which should result in improvements to the macroinvertebrate community in the Union River.

The wetted width of the riverine reach below Graham Lake, coupled with the depth at the flow release of 150 cfs, provided adequate wetted habitat for aquatic organisms in the Union River. The estimated wetted width at a flow of 105 cfs demonstrates there is very little difference in wetted width compared to the observed 150 cfs and minimum flow (Appendix E-4). Given that 105 cfs flow is the minimum flow proposed out of Graham Lake (from January 1 to March 31) and the minimum flow will be higher during other times of the year, the wetted zone of passage and habitat for aquatic organisms will remain adequate in the future. Further, during periods when inflow to Graham Lake is less than the required minimum flow, the Licensee shall continue to release the minimum flow by drawing from the impoundment.

4.4.2.3 Proposed Environmental Measures

Black Bear proposes operating the Project as specified in Section 3.3.3. Additionally, if MDEP continues to consider Lake Leonard Class B waters, Black Bear is proposing to implement a water quality enhancement program for Lake Leonard, as described in Section 3.3.4.

4.4.2.4 Cumulative Effects

In Scoping Document 1, the effects of continued Project operation on dissolved oxygen and water temperature in Lake Leonard, Graham Lake, and the Union River downstream of the Project were identified as an issue to be analyzed for both cumulative and site-specific effects. As specified in FERC’s cumulative effects analysis on water quality in the FEA, reducing the impoundment drawdown of Graham Lake from the existing range of 93.4 feet to 104.2 feet to the FERC recommended range of 98.5 to 103.0 feet would have a positive influence on cumulative effects on water quality in the Union River basin. It is anticipated that further reducing the range as proposed in Section 3.3.3, along with implementing a water quality enhancement program for Lake Leonard, would also have a positive influence on the cumulative effects on water quality in the Union River basin.

4.4.2.5 Unavoidable Adverse Impacts

The operation of the Ellsworth Project as proposed will result in no new adverse impacts to Project water quality. The proposed operations described in Section 3.3.3 will continue to result in portions of the littoral zone being dewatered, which could allow some erosion to continue.

Black Bear Hydro Partners, LLC (Black Bear) is the licensee of the Ellsworth Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2727) (Project). The Project, which consists of two developments – the Ellsworth Development and the Graham Lake Development, is located on the Union River in the City of Ellsworth, the Towns of Waltham and Mariaville, and the Township of Fletchers Landing in Hancock County, Maine.

Black Bear filed the Final License Application for the Project with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or Commission) on December 30, 2015. The Commission issued notice that the Project was ready for environmental analysis on February 9, 2018, and issued a Final Environmental Assessment on July 29, 2019.

On March 21, 2019, Black Bear applied to the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (MDEP) for Water Quality Certification (WQC) for the Project under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act. On March 19, 2020, the MDEP issued a Denial of WQC. An appeal process followed, culminating in a January 21, 2025 decision by the Maine Supreme Judicial Court, that *“Black Bear’s appeals to both the Superior Court and the Law Court must be dismissed as nonjusticiable, as no decision by either court would provide relief from the Board’s denial of the application for a Water Quality Certification.”*¹

Black Bear is preparing to file a new application for WQC. Pursuant to 40 CFR §121.4, an applicant is required to request a pre-filing meeting with the certifying authority at least 30 days prior to submitting a certification request. Accordingly, Black Bear is herein requesting a pre-filing meeting with the MDEP for the Project.

Black Bear Hydro Partners, LLC (Black Bear) is submitting a Water Quality Certification (WQC) application to the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (MDEP) for a New License for a Major Water Power Project for the Ellsworth Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2727) (Project). The hydroelectric Project consists of two developments, the Ellsworth Development and the Graham Lake Development, which are located on the Union River in the City of Ellsworth, the Towns of Waltham and Mariaville, and the Township of Fletchers Landing, Hancock County, Maine.

Within this application, Black Bear is providing the MDEP with the Final License Application (FLA) as well as prior documents filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) that revise, supplement, and/or correct deficiencies in the license application. Additionally, since the WQC application relies on the FERC license application, Black Bear has updated specific sections of the FLA for the MDEP to reflect the new proposed measures, which are being submitted within this application as specified below. Black Bear is also providing other pertinent documents that informed the development of the license application and, thereby, the WQC application.

The Ellsworth Development consists of the Ellsworth Dam, which forms Lake Leonard, and the associated generating facilities. Ellsworth Dam forms the upper limit of tidal influence on the Union River. The Graham Lake Development consists of a dam with a large storage reservoir (Graham Lake). There are no generating facilities at the Graham Lake Development. Water passes through the Project facilities before being discharged downstream. No pollutant discharge is proposed. Please see Exhibit B of the license application¹ for additional information on Project operation. Exhibit E of the license application² provides a map of the proposed site and a detailed description of the immediate vicinity and physical environment of the Project. Exhibit G of the license application³ provides the Project boundary.

The proposed activity will occur consistent with and over the term of the new license to be issued by FERC.


Applicable Project licenses and permits include the FERC license to be issued and the WQC. The FERC license has not been issued as of the date of this WQC application submittal. On April 9, 2018, the Licensee filed an initial Application for WQC with the MDEP. On March 21, 2019, Black Bear withdrew its April 9, 2018 application and filed a new application with the MDEP that materially revised its operating proposals in response to FERC's analysis in the Draft Environmental Assessment that was issued on November 21, 2018. On March 19, 2020, MDEP issued a denial of the certification, concluding that the Project, as proposed, would not meet water quality standards. An appeal process followed, which concluded in a January 21, 2025 decision that upheld the denial. Accordingly, and in consultation with the MDEP, Black Bear is filing a new application for WQC to reflect two new proposed measures for the operation of the Project, including modifying the operating regime for Graham Lake and a water quality enhancement program for Lake Leonard. Please see Section 1.3 of the Final Environmental Assessment issued by FERC on July 29, 2019, for additional information on the statutory and regulatory requirements of the Project.
