(Spills to unbroken asphalt or concrete of 10 Gallons or Less That Are Not Reported to the D.E.P.)

IMPORTANT: Petroleum spills of 10 gallons or less do not have to be reported to the Department IF: (1) The spills are to, and remain on, unbroken asphalt or concrete; (2) The spills are fully cleaned up within 24 hours, and; (3) A written spill log (this form or similar) is kept on file for the life of the facility. *This applies only to surface spills involving underground oil storage tanks. All other discharges to gravel or soil, spills above 10 gallons, spills not associated with an underground oil storage facility, or evidence of a leaking underground oil storage tank or piping must be reported to the Department of Environmental Protection.
