



**Surface Use Restriction**  
**Portion of Sebago Lake, Songo River, Casco, Maine**

Pursuant to 38 MRSA §1864, the Maine Departments of Environmental Protection (DEP) and Inland Fisheries and Wildlife (DIFW) hereby establish a temporary surface use restriction (SUR) on a four-acre portion of Sebago Lake, located within the Songo River, Casco, Maine. This area is adjacent to the Sebago Lake State Park public boat ramp. The approximate boundaries of the restricted area are shown on the image attached to this document.

The purpose of this surface use restriction is to, 1) support work to manage the aquatic invasive plant variable-leaf water milfoil, 2) prevent spread of this plant to other parts of the Songo River and Sebago Lake, and 3) provide a safe work environment for divers doing manual removal work.

By this Order, the restriction on watercraft during 2026 is as follows:

From April 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026 (unless canceled in writing by the Commissioners), no watercraft of any type may enter or travel the area of Sebago Lake indicated on the image accompanying this order.

Exceptions to this Order are limited to boat travel 1) in emergency situations where property or human safety is endangered, and 2) specifically allowed by the DEP or DIFW to survey for, remove invasive plants, deploy and retrieve fragment nets and buoys, and maintain fragment nets.

Buoys labeled "Area Closed" will be deployed along the boundary of the restricted area in the lake.

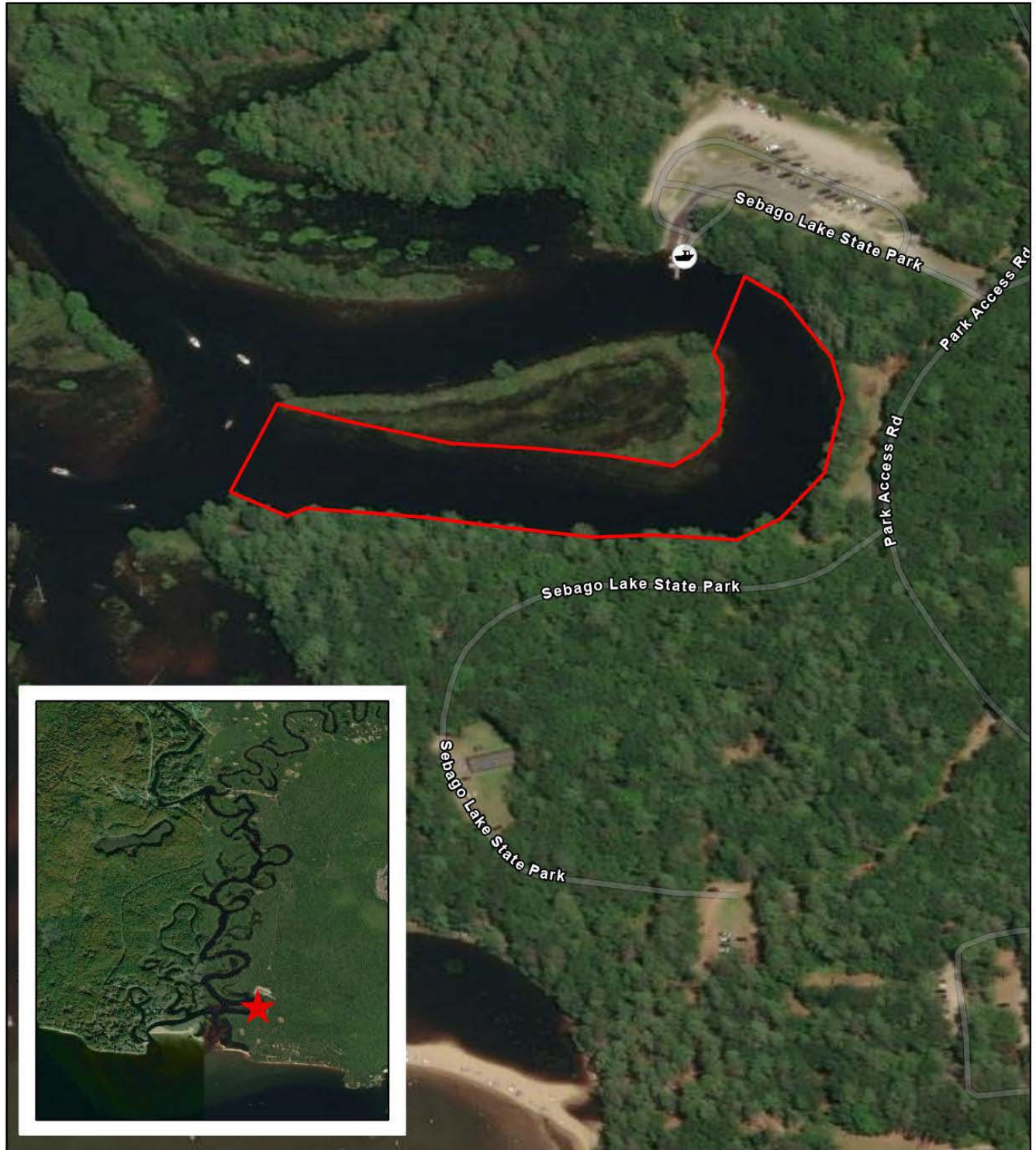
