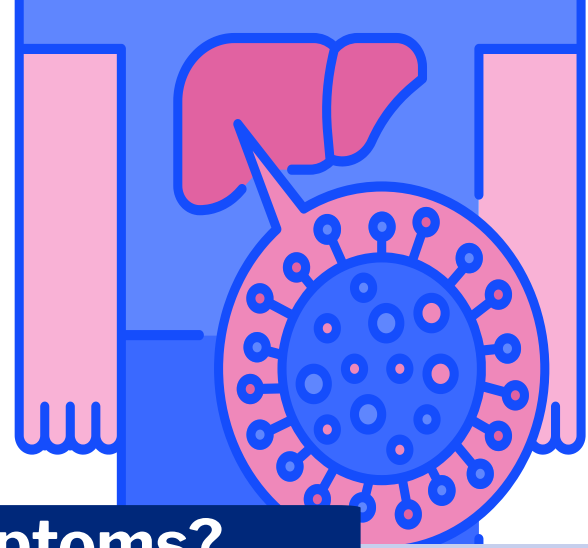


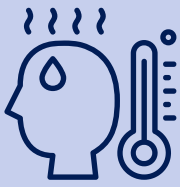
Prevent Hepatitis A: Get Vaccinated!

What is Hepatitis A?

Hepatitis A is a contagious liver disease caused by the hepatitis A virus.



What are some symptoms?



Fever



Nausea or vomiting



Stomach pain



Dark urine or diarrhea



Loss of appetite

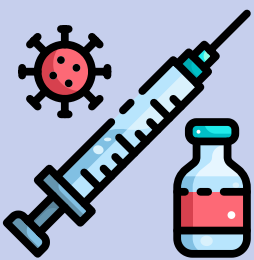


Yellow eyes or skin



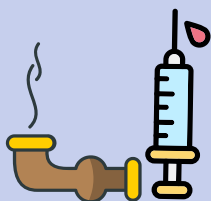
Feeling very tired

How can I prevent Hepatitis A?



The best way to prevent hepatitis A infection is to get vaccinated. Talk with a health care provider about the hepatitis A vaccine!

Wash your hands with soap often.



Avoid sharing needles and other drug materials. Use new needles or reuse your own materials every time you use.
