Maine CDC is pleased to share that the State Health Improvement Plan (SHIP) process has been completed. They are now transitioning into work groups according to priorities that stemmed from the assessment.

The Maine Shared Community Health Needs Assessment (Me SCHNA) has held all of their county forums. The draft reports will be written and final reports are expected in the spring of 2025.

Hazard Vulnerability Assessments (HVA) were conducted at the District-, and more recently, State-Level. The District Healthcare Coalition (HCC) Chapters continue to meet regularly.
