Thank you for the State of Maine's October 5, 2004, letter requesting to incorporate numerous changes to the Maine Coastal Program based on public laws enacted by the 121st Maine Legislature during its Second Regular and Second Special Sessions, from January 7, 2004, and April 30, 2004. You specifically requested that these program changes be incorporated as routine program changes (RPCs) per the Coastal Zone Management Act (CZMA) regulations at 15 C.F.R. Part 923 Subpart H and the Office of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management's (OCRM) Final Program Change Guidance of July 8, 1996.

No comments from the public or federal agencies were received on the State's RPC request. Based on our review of your submission, we concur with your determination that the changes to sections noted below are routine program changes and are approved as enforceable policies of the Maine Coastal Program (MCP).

All changes apply to Public Law 2003 and were enacted on July 30, 2004, with the exception of Public Law 2003, chapter 573 (see below).


