5/1/2024	Indefinite	<u>Pirates Creek:</u> From the abandoned car on an unnamed point of Sewards Neck (northeast of Pirates Creek) south to Hannah Miller Point to the adjacent subtidal.	Closed
10/1/2023	6/21/2024	Mowry Beach: Starting at a red post at the base of the staircase at the shoreline adjacent to Easy Street, running south to a red post 300 meters north of Woodward Point, east through the Spark Plug to the Canadian border, north to meet the Narrows State Pollution Closure (ET, P2).	Closed
6/29/2022	Indefinite	Minzey Place – South and west of a line beginning at a red painted post on the southeast tip of West Quoddy Bar, running southeast to the shore approximately 600 yards east of the intersection of the West Quoddy Head Road and Carryingplace Road. (covers State Pollution Closure ES, R1)	Closed
6/29/2022	Indefinite	Johnson Bay and Lubec Narrows – South and east of a line beginning at the northern tip of Diamond Point, then running northeast to the northern tip of Popes Folly; AND south of a line beginning at the northern tip of Popes Folly then running east to the US/Canadian Border; AND west of a line following the US/Canadian Border south to a point east of Mowery Point; AND north of a line beginning at a point on the US/Canadian border east of Mowery Point then running west to the eastern tip of Mowery Point. (covers State Pollution Closure ET, P2)	Closed
