

Title I, Part A Education Technician (Ed-Tech) Requirements

Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) & Code of Federal Regulations (CFR)

<u>ESEA Statute</u> Section 1111(g)(2)(M) requires Education Technicians to follow the requirements put into place before Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 was enacted. These standards come from the Code of Federal Regulations 200.58.

To provide instructional support for Title I students, Ed Tech I's must acquire an ESFA Endorsement.

- This endorsement can be received by taking 48 hours of college coursework, shown by submitting an official transcript within the Maine Educator Information System (MEIS) platform.
- The ESEA endorsement can also be received by passing the ParaPro Assessment with a score of at least 459.
