



# Title I, Part A Education Technician (Ed-Tech) Requirements

Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) & Code of Federal Regulations (CFR)

[ESEA Statute](#) Section 1111(g)(2)(M) requires Education Technicians to follow the requirements put into place before Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 was enacted. These standards come from the [Code of Federal Regulations 200.58](#).

To provide instructional support for Title I students, Ed Tech I's must acquire an ESEA Endorsement.

- This endorsement can be received by taking 48 hours of college coursework, shown by submitting an official transcript within the Maine Educator Information System (MEIS) platform.
- The ESEA endorsement can also be received by passing the [ParaPro Assessment](#) with a score of at least 459.
