* General Duty citation would include hazards such as:

Fire Departments: No inspection of fire ladders, fire hose, firefighting turnout gear, and training commensurate with duties was not complete.

Law Enforcement: Training commensurate with duties was not complete.

Public Works Department, Sewer, Water, Sanitary Districts, and Transfer Recycling Facilities: No inspection of vehicle lifts and jack stands, emergency stop devices were not operational, and training not completed for duties performed.

Educational Facilities: No inspection of vehicle lifts and emergency stop devices were not operational.
