

Pipe Cleaner Hyacinth



Materials Included: Pipe cleaners (1 purple or other, 1 green)

Step 1: Place the green pipe cleaner on the pencil so that the tips line up. Starting about 2" from the end, tightly wind the purple pipe cleaner around the pencil and green pipe cleaner. Keep winding until you get to the end, making sure the windings get more narrow as you get to the tip.

Step 2: Carefully remove the pencil from the pipe cleaners. If the windings look too "perfect" bend the flower a little to give it more character.
