ADVISORY RULING #52 MARCH 11, 1981

Revocation: AR #41, 43, 43-A

March 11, 1981

In light of the Bureau's decision in <u>Bill Dodge Oldsmobile</u> issued on February 11, 1981, AR #41, 43, and 43-A are hereby revoked. Henceforth, the Bureau will allow a creditor to contract for and collect reasonable repossession expenses pursuant to 11 M.R.S.A. §9-504 (Uniform Commercial Code). Section 2-507 of the Consumer Credit Code will continue to be interpreted to disallow attorney's fees for any consumer credit sales and for consumer loans with an APR in excess of 12½%, as well as "collection costs" in general or any costs not specifically allowed by law. See Section 3-402 of the Code.
