A hearing on the merger application will be held by the Bank Superintendent, as provided in Title 9-B M.R.S.A. Section 252, upon receipt of a bona fide and reasonable request. The Bureau will accept written comments and requests for a hearing through Friday, October 13, 2006. The Superintendent's decision on the merger application will be based on the decision-making criteria set forth in Title 9-B M.R.S.A. Section 253.

Comments on the field of membership expansion will not be accepted inasmuch as that notice is not an application process subject to the decision-making process set forth in Title 9-B M.R.S.A. Section 252. However, as required by Title 9-B M.R.S.A. Section 814(1)(B), the Superintendent will provide notice to interested parties on the decision on the bylaw amendment.
