[¶1] Twin Rivers Paper Company, LLC, appealed an August 23, 2016, decision of the Workers' Compensation Board Appellate Division, *Bourgoin v. Twin Rivers Paper Company, LLC*, Me. W.C.B. No. 16-26 (App. Div. 2016), to the Maine Supreme Judicial Court, sitting as the Law Court. The Law Court issued its decision on June 14, 2018, with the following mandate:

Judgement vacated. Remanded to the Workers' Compensation Appellate Division with instructions to vacate the decision of the hearing officer and remanded for denial of the petition for payment of medical expenses and services.

Bourgoin v. Twin Rivers Paper Company, LLC, 2018 ME 77, --- A.3d ---.

[¶2] Pursuant to that mandate, Appellate Division decision No. 16-26 is now vacated. The decision of the administrative law judge (*Pelletier, ALJ*) granting

the Petition for Payment of Medical and Related Services is also vacated, and the case is remanded for entry of a decision denying that petition, consistent with the Law Court's decision.
