[¶1] The University of Maine System appeals from a decision of a Workers' Compensation Board Administrative Law Judge (*Elwin, ALJ*) dated July 15, 2015, as modified by findings of fact and conclusions of law dated April 14, 2017. The only issues raised on appeal challenge the ALJ's decision that the University of Maine System is required to reimburse Mr. Crandall for expenses related to the purchase of medical marijuana.

[¶2] This appeal has been stayed pending the Law Court's decision in *Bourgoin v. Twin Rivers Paper Company, LLC*, 2018 ME 77, ___ A.3d ___ (decided June 14, 2018).

[¶3] By agreement of the parties, and pursuant to *Bourgoin*, the board's July 15, 2015, and April 14, 2017, decision is now vacated insofar as it requires the

University of Maine System to reimburse Mr. Crandall for the purchase of medical marijuana. Mr. Crandall's Petition for Payment of Medical and Related Services remains otherwise granted.
